Park Locations & Amenities

Park facilities may be reserved in advance by contacting the Parks & Recreation Department at (816) 630-1040.

East Valley Park: Located just south of Isley Boulevard, between Isley and Lovers Lane. The park has three pavilions with several picnic tables and cooking facilities. Walk trails are located on the south and north sides of the park with Fishing River running through the park.

Isley Park Woods: Located on the south side of East Valley Park. Isley Park Woods was named a state natural area by the Missouri Department of Conservation. The park features a natural footpath for interested trekkers.

Fishing River Linear Park Trail: Is found adjacent to Jim Piburn Field and consists of over one mile of asphalt walking/jogging trail. The trail runs from Golf Hill Bridge to an area east of the Marietta Street Bridge.

Jim E. Piburn Ball Field: Formerly known as “Siloam Ball Field,” this field is located just south of Broadway in downtown Excelsior Springs. Enter on Saratoga Avenue next to Saratoga Manor.

Paul Craig Park: Located adjacent to Jim Piburn Field this park offers playground equipment for young children to enjoy.

West Complex: Is centrally located between the Excelsior Springs Middle and High Schools. It consists of three ball diamonds, shelter houses, restrooms, and concession stand for your convenience.

Sunnyside Park: Located at Dunbar and Beverly Streets, offers ADA accessible playground equipment, two pavilions and eight acres of green grass and rolling hills to play in.

Siloam Mountain Park: Covers 25 acres off Garland Street on Ellsworth. This is a great location to really see Excelsior Springs as it sets higher than most of the town. Three pavilions, playground equipment, picnic tables, and barbeque facilities are scattered throughout the park.

Kibler Park: Located on Dunbar Street sets on one acre and has ADA accessible playground equipment, swings, and a basketball court. Practicing and playing baseball/softball is not permitted.

Lincoln Park: Located on Osage Street, this park has a pavilion and playground equipment situated on two acres.

Raper Park: Can be found near the intersection of Orrick and Seybold Roads. Raper Park sets on 16 acres of open, grassy areas, which makes it ideal to play softball, baseball, flag football and soccer.

Kent and Outlook: Located at Kent and Outlook streets.

Regent Park: Is located on Marietta Street across from the old Roosevelt School. It offers new tennis and basketball courts. Swings are also available for your enjoyment.
